



Religious Education Teaching

At Beardall Fields we use the Nottinghamshire Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education, "RE for All". This Syllabus enables our pupils to gain insights and knowledge to equip them as responsible members in our society.

The Syllabus encourages pupils to discover more about religion and world views on a range of topics. They are encouraged to express ideas and insights into key questions.

The three fold aims of RE will ensure that our pupils:

1. know and understand a range of religions and world views which will allow them to recognise the diversity which exists in our society.
2. can express ideas and insights about religions and world views as they develop their own personal views on a range of issues.
3. develop and use skills which will assist them to engage seriously with religions and world views.

By following the Agreed Syllabus, RE will contribute to a whole range of school priorities. It will promote spiritual, cultural, social and moral development, as well as enabling pupils to consider British Values such as tolerance and respect for others who hold different world views.
