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- Guarantee Element of the State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit

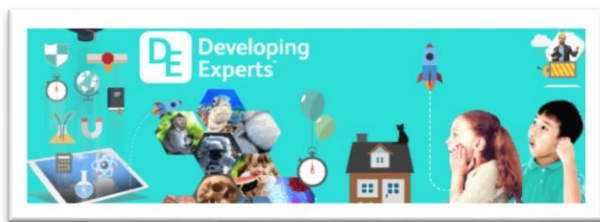
