How does life in Kenya compare to ours?

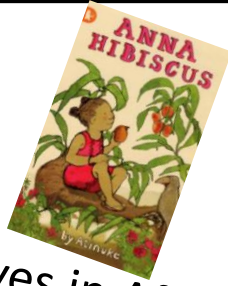
How is school life similar or different to schooling in the UK?

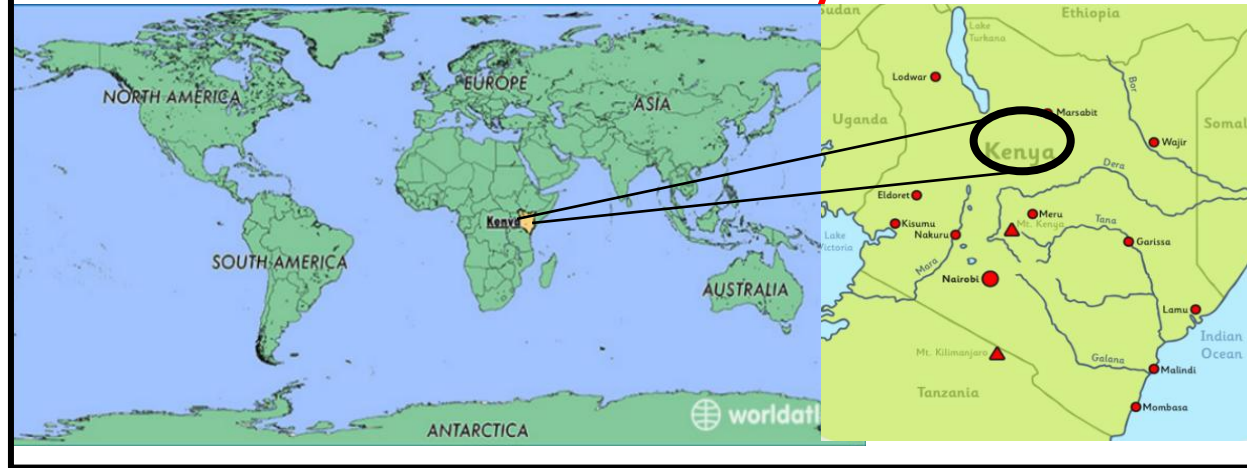


Anna Hibiscus lives in Africa and is so happy she doesn't know what to do with all her happiness, so she sets off to ask her family.

Nairobi	Capital city of Kenya
Dry	Having little or no rainfall.
Compare	Look for similarities between two things.
Savannah	Tropical grassland with small or dispersed trees
Continent	Huge area of land separated by water.
Rural	Characteristics of the countryside.
Urban	Characteristics of a town or city.
