- Details in artefacts and pictures help us to understand the past.

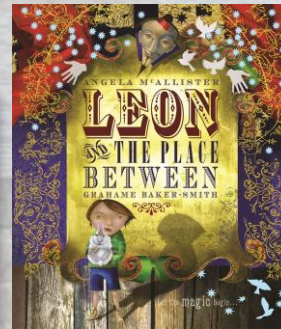
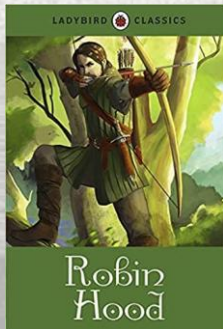

Aerial	Happening in the air or atmosphere.
Coordinates	Definition of a position of a point using a system of lines and numbers as a reference.
Compass	An instrument for finding directions which indicates magnetic north.
Population growth	The rate at which the population number of people in a given area) grows or expands.
Legend	An old story that is widely believed but cannot be proved to be true.
Legacy	Something that is handed down from one period of history to another.
