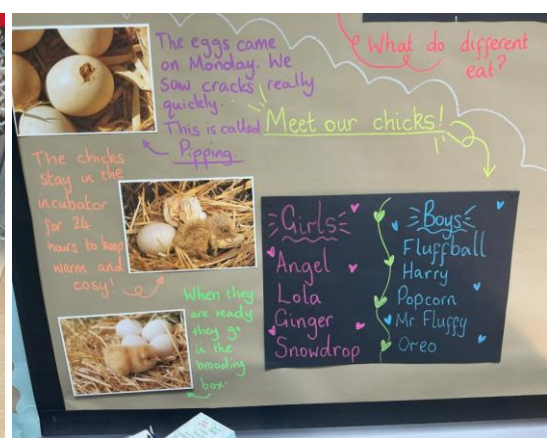
### Father's Day Sale
