## PTA Disco

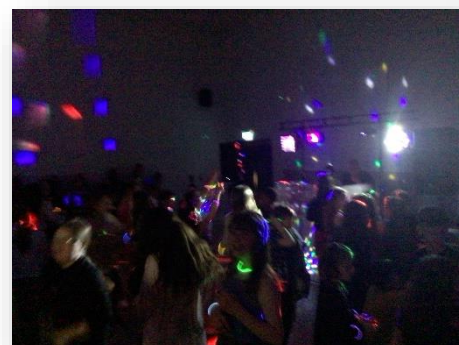
We had a huge turnout for our three discos this week. Thank you for all your support. We hope the children had a fantastic time and we really enjoyed putting on the event for them.

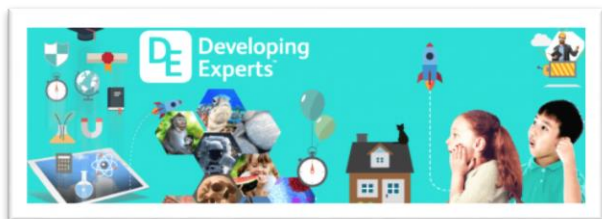
